

4Who is pronounced "for who" - four Ws and One H, plus the o for good measure. (haha!) Really, 4Who is for me, and it's for you. Some people use the SOAP (scripture, observation, application, prayer) method of Bible Study. Others use SOAK or another acronym. But I think it's really important to know the whos and the whys for scripture. Why it was written to a certain people group, or how that scripture passage introduces us to the nature of God. The 4Who method is what i use to help me understand.

Whichever method you use, I hope you grow to love learning about the Bible as much as I do.

This is your cover sheet and print alignment test page. **MAKE SURE YOU PRINT THIS PAGE.**

Change your scale % until you see what you like best for size. A few notes:

1. Print this cover page to test the size, but also once you have the size you like it acts as your cutting guide.

2. Print front to back. Test a couple of pages, front to back (such as page 18-19). Make sure the binding edge or flip-on-edge is what you need. *For instance, on my own printer, I print as:*

- **Landscape View**

- **70%**

- **Double-Sided Printing, Flip on short edge binding**

- **28 lb bright white paper (thinner, but thicker than regular printer paper) or 32 lb paper (thicker feel). I prefer 32 for my personal planner, but for my Engineer's Planner, I will use 28 lb paper or regular printer paper.**

Once I have mine printed, I trim the edges. If you print off multiples, or print dozens of sheets at a time, you can take it to an office supply store and have them trim the edges. At oyr local store it's around \$3 to do this. The pages are offset on purpose with more margin on the left side to allow for your coil, discs, or the rings of your planner.

If you prefer to trim at home, just do all sheets of one side at a time so you keep the cutting guide aligned.

After trimming, hole punch or wire bind it.
